Volunteer events 2017

Feb – Bird and bat box assembly for Belle Vue

Preparation and planting of new pollinator bed in Belle Vue

March – Snowdrop planting at Beechwood (provisional)

April – Wild flower area preparation and sowing of seed at Beechwood

June/July – Green flag preparation at Belle Vue

August – Clearing of Wild flower meadows at both parks

September – Evergreen shrub pruning at Beechwood

Semi ripe cutting at Belle Vue Nursery (provisional) +
(Volunteers can take some home for their own gardens)

October – Bulb planting at both parks (provisional)

November/December – Leaf raking + take your own bags home for leaf mould compost at Both parks

December – Hardwood cuttings at Beechwood + (Volunteers can take some home for their own gardens)
