Our day starts with a visit to the bustling Cotswold town of Moreton in Marsh. It is situated on the ancient Fosse Way, has a wide main street with old inns and shops. The town charter dates from 1227 and, I believe, Tuesday is market day.

In the afternoon we shall be visiting Hidcote Manor Garden. It is one of the most influential English Gardens of the 20<sup>th</sup> century with linked 'garden rooms'. It is a garden of plants but designed with an artist's eye. It has been described as 'a cottage garden' on the most glorified scale.
