Kew is a UNESCO world heritage site and one of the most famous gardens in the world. It combines the most historic centre of scientific research, horticulture, the largest and most diverse collections and royal patronage.

The Kew Explorer land train runs around the gardens every thirty minutes. It costs £5 and you can get on and off at any stage. There are lots of seats and cloakroom facilities all around the site. Cafes and restaurants can be expensive but selection is good. Excellent shops for plants, souvenirs, etc.

Your ticket gives entry to Kew Palace, the Palm House, Queen Charlotte's cottage, a tree top walkway, beehive in the air, waterlily house, ten climatic zones, the Great Pagoda, Princess of Wales conservatory, alpine house, kitchen garden and much, much more.
